

## Homeless Youth Services

State and Local Educational Agencies must ensure each homeless child and youth has equal access to the same free, appropriate public education, including public preschool, as other children and youth. The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act ensures educational rights and protections for children and youth experiencing homelessness.

The Solano County Office of Education and Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District work together to provide support and resources to implement the McKinney-Vento Act.

Support services to youth experiencing home displacement are as follows:

- The right to immediate enrollment in school regardless of living situation
- Assistance with school services to maintain educational stability
- Opportunities for academic success
- Assistance with obtaining immunizations and medical records
- Continued attendance in the school in which last enrolled
- Receive transportation from your current residence to school of origin
